The Paulita Generator: QUANTUM SOLDIER OF THE FUTURE

WASHINGTON — U.S. intelligence officials are studying Soviet development of "psychotronic generators." The devices use quantum fields to "draw biological energy from humans; the energy is accumulated and stored for future use." A description of these Pavlita generators is part of an ongoing study by the U.S. Army Medical Intelligence and Information Agency in the Surgeon General's Office.

The Army study entitled "Soviet and Czechoslovakian Parapsychology Research," written by Maj. J.D. LaMothe, JSC and Louis E. Maire III, states that Robert Pavlita's generators could be (and possibly are now) used to train large numbers of Soviet and Czech soldiers, scientists, and athletes to develop, enhance, and control special abilities from the best in each field. Such a cadre of trained, but anonymous individuals, could be used for any number of covert activities.

"Less spectacular, but more significant," La Mothe and Maire go on to say, "is that Soviet and Czech scientists are pursuing an interrelated, unified approach to determine the energy sources and interactions underlying bioenergetic superpositions, the non-algorithmic quantum foundation of consciousness."

Details about the construction of Pavlita generators are a closely guarded secret but reportedly the devices are fabricated from various metals, such as silver, bronze, copper, and gold. Their effects are a result of their form (one of the drawings of a psychotronic generator

reproduced in the Pentagon document resembles a modernistic globe-type table lamp with a thick stem).

Although the nature of this quantum energy is not understood, its effects have been reported by Czech scientists. It can be reflected, polarized and combined with other forms of energy.

Subatomic physics is critical to the Soviet conception of psychotronics and transferable human consciousness. They emphasize "the dematerialized character of contemporary physics, a science filled with such bizarre components as advance potential (waves of electrons perceived before they are generated)" and "tunneling effects (electrons penetrating barriers which, by the laws of probability, should be impenetrable)."

Czechoslovakian researchers link psychotronic transfer to "mental ions", or "mentions". One form of mention may be Parnov's telepathic analogue to the neutrino or tachyon, the "luxon". Frantisek Kahuda of Charles University, Prague, theorizes "an entire conglomerate of elementary mention fields... that exist in nature independently of the will of all human beings... it will now be possible to develop quantum mentiodynamics as the quantum theory of mention fields."

According to LaMothe and Maire, "Communist parapsychologists argue that after decades of research, conventional science still has no satisfactory neurophysiological explanation of memory, nor is there any appropriate model for explaining

how raw data impugning on man's senses are transformed into a conscious experience."

The Pavlita generators have been tested by experts from the Czechoslovakian Academy of Scientists and the University of Hradec Kralove in Prague. According to the report, Dr. Jiri Bradna demonstrated that such patterns could be transmitted between subjects using quartz-copper ionic containers, blocked or dissipated with ferrous metal filters and aluminum, and reflected and transmitted over copper-gold waveguides.

"The best devices consist of rods or tubes suspended horizontally by a monofilament thread, foils in the shape of narrow rectangles rotating about their minor axis, or circular planes rotating about their diameter. A glass jar or cylinder can be packed in a grounded Faraday cage of wo-

ven wire."

In their present form and size, U.S. Army researchers say that Pavlita devices could exert an effect on humans for only short durations. However, with greater power both duration and energy might be amplified, extending their effectiveness.

If Czech claims for the Pavlita devices are valid, biological energy might be an effective special operations program. Such a program would be difficult to defend against, since it would make anonymous trainees as dangerous as well-known trained assassins and other special ops personnel.

By storing the skills of highly trained individuals, they could be transferred to completely anonymous trainees in minutes. "Soviet or Czech perfection of psychotronic weapons could pose a severe threat to enemy military, embassy, or secu-

rity functions. The psychotronically energized individual would be difficult to detect and turn any human into an anonymous super-soldier."

More sinister uses could potentially create animal/human hybrids. "Present day Soviet and Czech parapsychology animal research is devoted almost exclusively to the investigation of the biological energy of physiological processes, the interactions of such energy with external fields, and the effects of externally generated fields on animal physiology."

The military document concludes that Robert Pavlita's work with psychotronic generators is "the most important contemporary development in the field of parapsychology, and a major contribution to the deeper understanding, mastery, and utilization of biological quantum energy for human advantage." □

"He moved in large jumps, his feet lightly touching the ground, and disappeared into the distant woods."

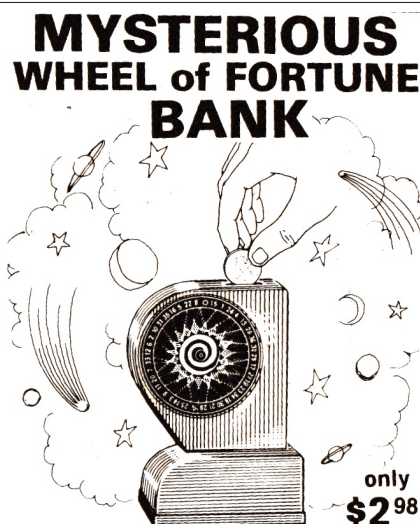
The girls noticed that he seemed to be wearing "a close-fitting garment which was looser around the legs. A short piece of material seemed to flap around his bottom."
